**Patient presentation:**

53years, Female, Negative family history

History of left breast modified radical mastectomy (2011) followed by chemotherapy, radiotherapy and letrozole.

Regional recurrence in supraclavicular lymph nodes that underwent open neck biopsy: suggestive of metastatic carcinoma, ER+ PR+ HER (4/2018).

Ultrasound exam (6/2018): Highly Suspicious Lymph nodes in left supraclavicular area and posterior triangle .

Abdomino-pelvic CT: Normal. Whole body bone scan: Normal.

Her neck got re-irradiated (7/2018).

Ultrasound (11/2018): some hypo-echoic regions with irregular borders in sub-dermal area of Zone 5 of the neck, suggesting suspicious Lymph nodes.
