Patient presentation:

- 35 years – negative family history
- History of triple negative right breast cancer underwent lumpectomy, chemotherapy and radiotherapy (2017/05)
- She experienced a local recurrence which was treated by mastectomy and axillary dissection (2018/03)
- Left breast cancer coincidentally happened with papillary carcinoma of thyroid and was treated by total thyroidectomy + central neck dissection and left modified radical mastectomy (2018/10)
- 3 of 8 pathologic lymph node harvested from thyroidectomy had breast pathology
- She has a 2*2 cm mass in her right lateral zone of neck
