Patient Presentation:

- A 59 year old female with right breast cancer 7 years ago(1391)underwent MRM. Pathology examination reported IDC+DCIS, T=3.9cm, G2, 15 out of 19 LNs involved, ER+, PR+, HER2+, Ki70%. FISH was not done and she didn't receive Herceptin.

-4 years ago(1394), she presented with brain metastases (ER+, PR-, HER2+, Ki30%) and underwent surgery and chemoRT.

-2 years ago(1396) she presented with local recurrence(chest wall and axilla) and liver 8th segment metastases(ER+, PR+, HER2+). She received 6 courses of chemotherapy (Taxotere) with good response.

-Her recent imaging: Normal thoracic and abdominopelvic CT scan; Increased uptake in 8th segment of liver, right axilla, right iliac(SUV=6.7) and T6(SUV=3.3) in PET-CT scan;

Question: Is simultaneous local surgery and metastasectomy is recommended?

Recommended Plan: Surgery is not recommended. Systemic therapy should be continued.
