Patient Presentation:

-A 44 year old female with right breast invasive ductal carcinoma (IHC: ER-, HER+) which underwent BCS.

-She scheduled for adjuvant chemoRT. After 2nd course of chemotherapy she presented with right hemithorax skin lesions which progressed to diffuse lesions in anterior right hemithorax, medial part of left breast, and upper abdomen.

-Lesions was biopsied and proved to be recurrence.

-She had no response to chemoRT.

Question: Is surgery justified?

Recommended Plan: Further chemotherapy and palliative treatment, no surgical intervention according to diffuse tumoral involvement.
