Patient Presentation:

- A39year old female with negative family history and history of papillomatosis of breast
- 5 years ago: left breast mass, 13mm
- Surgery and pathology: excision, intra-ductal papilloma
- 2 years ago: right breast mass
- Surgery and pathology: excision, sclerosing papilloma
- 1 years ago: bloody nipple discharge, and tissue in compression by physician
- Pathology: intra ductal papilloma
- Recent sonography: 12*7mm lobulated mass with internal micro-calcification (increased in size) in left breast 8 o'clock BIRADS IVa, multiple masses in both breasts in favor of bilateral papillomatosis
- Recent mammography: asymmetric density with micro-calcification in UOQ of left breast

Question: does she eligible for bilateral mastectomy?

Recommended Plan: she is not candidate for mastectomy, biopsy of mass witch is BIRADS Iva, recommendation of tamoxifen



Breast MRI shows bilateral papillomatosis
