**Patient Presentation:**

- A 49year old female, right axillary lymph adenopathy from 9 months ago
- Sonography: axillary masses 43,39,20,27 mm
- Excisional biopsy: Merkel cell carcinoma
- Octreotide scan: uptakes in right axilla, breast, supraclavicular, hemi thorax
- Systemic treatment: chemotherapy 10 courses, cis- etoposide
- Octreotide scan: reduction in tumor volume in chest wall
- MRI of breasts: huge lobulated mass of axilla 145\*60mm, involvement of pectoralis muscles and chest wall, right lung, multiple suspicious mass in breasts

**Question:** What is the next plan?

**Recommended Plan:** Target sonography of breast, chest CT scan, she benefits from surgery or radiation therapy followed by surgery for local control and then systemic therapy
