- MRI couldn't be done due to her mental status.
- Bone scan anterior of left 6th rib suspicious

Question: What is the best plan? MRM or beginning with chemotherapy? tissue diagnosis necessary?

Recommended tests: Metastatic work up be done. If no metastasis found contralateral axillary lymph node biopsy should be the next step.
