**Patient presentation:**

- 32years, Mental retard female-negative family history
- Presented with multiple huge left breast necrotic hyperplastic masses throughout it and multiple suspicious LNs in both axillary regions.
- Ultrasound : BIRADS 5
- CNB: Cancer of Mucinous type. ER+90-100% ; PR +60% ; HER2- ; ki67 20%
- MRI couldn't be done due to her mental status.
- Bone scan anterior of left 6<sup>th</sup> rib suspicious

**Question:** What is the best plan? MRM or beginning with chemotherapy? tissue diagnosis necessary?

**Recommended tests:** Metastatic work up be done. If no metastasis found contralateral axillary lymph node biopsy should be the next step.

**Considered plan:** In case of contralateral axillary involvement proceed to both side MRM. Otherwise left side MRM and Hormone therapy.
