Patient presentation:

- 50years female
- Presented with Right breast new mass in routine screening.
- Sonography: A mass13*6 mm in lower central zone of right breast. (BIRADS4b).

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-CNB: IDC; Grade2; severe stromal lymphocytic infiltration.

-Wire guided partial mastectomy done.

-Pathology report: Invasive carcinoma 1.5 *0.8cm (ductal type with smooth border); G2; high grade DCIS; No lymphovascular or perineural invasion seen. ER+; PR+; her2 2+(FISH -); ki67 6-8%. Medial and inferior margins involved with foci of DCIS. All 5sentinel and 4 non sentinel lymph nodes were free of tumor.

-The patient is not willing to receive chemotherapy.

Question: Next plan (Need to chemotherapy)?

Recommended tests: Oncotype Dx.

Considered plan: Due to lack of the aforementioned test, at least 4 courses of chemotherapy (TC) are recommended if she doesn't accept then ovarian suppression and aromatase inhibitor usage is necessary. Also, re-excision of both involved margins is proposed.
