PEx: multiple right breast mass (UIQ and UOQ)

US: multiple and multicentric mass+ Axillary suspicious LAP

CNBx(right 2&10 o'clock mass): IDC,G2, LCIS+, LVI-, ER+(90%), PR+(90%) HER2-, Ki67 30-35%

LN FNA: positive

**Recommendation:**

1. Right side SSM instead of NSM is recommended.
2. Left side prophylactic mastectomy could be done.
