Patient presentation:

A 70 year-old woman with neck ulcerated huge mass since 2 months ago who underwent open biopsy

Neck mass Biopsy: poorly differentiated carcinoma (Breast or Salivary Gland origin)

IHC: GATA3+, CK+, ER-

CT: A huge tumoral mass in left side of neck, 118mm, without vascular encasement and post neck triangle & left supraclavicular metastatic lymph nodes

MG: No mass (B0)

US: some left reactive axillary lymph nodes

Breast MRI: normal

Question:

What's the next plan?

Recommendation:

- 1.GATA3 positive in Breast, Salivary Gland, and TCC malignancy origin.
2. Salivary gland and head & neck tumor are more probable.
