CT: collapse Fracture in T3/7

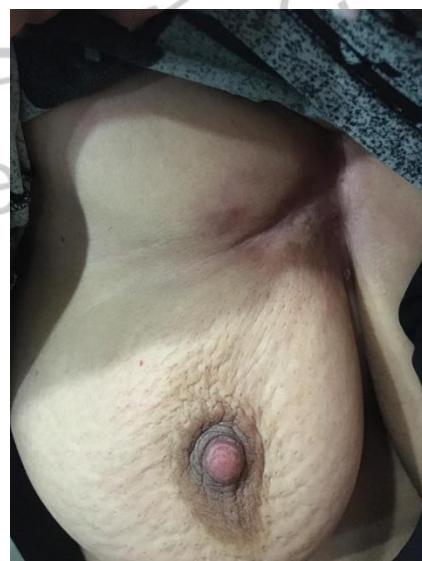
Question:

Is toilet mastectomy recommended?

Recommendation:

1. Hormone therapy is recommended(no surgery).
2. Whole spine and femor MRI and Radiotherapy is recommended if any bone lesions were reported.



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
