Patient presentation:

A 60 year-old woman with left breast mass underwent lumpectomy and SLNB

FH: negative

Imaging: Left 3 o'clock 12mm spiculated mass (B4c)

CNBx: complex sclerosing lesion

Pathology: Invasive Tubular carcinoma, T=1cm, free margins, LVI-, ER 3%, HER2 -, Ki67 3%, 0/2 SLNB

Pathology review: Low grade adenosquamous carcinoma, Triple negative, Ki67 17%

Question:

What is the next plan?

Should she undergo systemic therapy ?

Recommendation:

1. Chemotherapy is not needed.
2. Radiotherapy is recommended.
