A 40 year-old lady with mass sensation in left breast UOQ since 3 months ago  
US: 41\*32 mm mass containing microcalcification without any suspicious lymph node  
CNBx:ER >90% +,PR>90% +,HER2 -,Ki67 10-12%  
Underwent BSC+SLN: 4cm IDC, G2/3, 1/2 SLNs involved in frozen section but 4/4  
sentinel and non-sentinel lymph nodes involved without extra nodal extension, free  
surgical margins

**Question:**

What is the next plan?  
Does she need axillary dissection?  
If yes, what about timing (before or after chemotherapy).

**Recommendation:**

- 1.Surgical axillary dissection.
- 2.Systemic chemoradiotherapy after operation is recommended.
