**MRI:** Right breast; irregular mass with non-mass enhancement 14\*14 mm at 6 o'clock, with a satellite lesion. There is a 6.8 cm non-mass enhancement at 9 o'clock left breast and a 4.2 cm non-mass enhancement at 9 o'clock. All aforementioned lesions are considered as B4.

**US guided biopsy of right breast:**

6 o'clock lesion: fibroadenomatoid changes

**Non-mass area:** FCC with mild ductal hyperplasia

Are MRI lesions suspicious?

If MRI result is suspicious what's the next plan according to her radio-pathological discordance?
