Sonography: hypoechoic irregular mass 7x 6 mm 10 o'clock left breast B4c

CNB: IDC

She underwent BCS & axillary LN dissection.

Pathology left axilla LNs: fibroadipose tissue

Pathology left breast: invasive carcinoma with tubular & lobular features, G2, 5mm, LVI - ,ER+ 70%, PR+ 80%, HER2 -, Ki67 8%, E cadherin+, margins are free

Abdominopelvic CT: normal

Surgery of axilla or radiotherapy?

SLNBx & if she doesn't accept then radiotherapy should be done.
