**Patient's Name:** S.M

**Responsible Physician:** Dr.Lashgari

**Patient presentation:** A 48 year-old lady that was presented with right breast mass in 1399.

**Sono:** multiple hypoechoic mass in right axilla (LN?) & intramammary LN in 1 o'clock of right breast.

**Mamo:** focal asymmetry in UOQ of right breast and axillary LN

**CHEST CT:** 4 axillary LN

**Abdominopelvic CT:** no metastasis

**Breast MRI:** iso T2 angulated mass 26x 21 may be due to malignant mass or metastatic intermammary LN B5

**Brain MRI :** no metastasis

She underwent axillary lumpectomy 6 months ago.

**Pathology:** metastatic high grade IDC, ER -, PR -, HER2 +, CK7 +, GATA3 +, GCDFGP15 +

She underwent chemotherapy (6 courses )+ Herceptin

**MRI after chemotherapy :** a few suspicious thick cortex LN at right axilla( metastatic) B6 & a suspicious thick cortex LN in left axilla B4

The patient did not want to have surgery again

**Question:**

What's the next plan?

**Recommendation:**

Nonoperative management.
