Patient's Name: R.H

Patient presentation: A 31-year-old female with right breast mass

Sonography: multiple irregular multi focal mass with skin thickening in LOQ and central part of her right breast and prominent axillary LN (B5)

Mammography: irregular focal asymmetries in right breast in favor of multi centric involvement (B4c)

CNB: IDC (ER 90%, PR 35%, HER-2 3+, Ki67 10%) **LN:** positive

Bone scan: multiple bone/bone marrow metastatic lesions

Pelvic MRI: posterior left iliac 16 mm & 13 mm metastatic bone lesion

Liver MRI: small liver nodule suggestive for metastasis and T12 body metastasis
8 courses of NAC were done for her.

Does she get benefit from surgery?
