**Patient presentation:** A 61 year-old woman underwent neoadjuvant chemotherapy 8 courses due to right breast cancer (30x33 mm mass with axillary lymphadenopathy) After that underwent MRM

Pathology: IDC, triple negative, Ki67 20-25 %, 1 of 8 LNs was positive.

In follow up was one liver mass in sonography.

MRI: one liver mass in segment 2 or 3

Pet scan: one liver metastasis

**Question:**

What's the next plan? Metastatectomy or chemotherapy?

**Recommendation:**

- 1-Targeted sonography from liver metastasis.
- 2-Core needle biopsy from liver mass.
- 3-Genetic consult.
