Patient's Name: L.H

Patient presentation: A 37 year-old lady presented with mass in left breast.

Mammography: generalized breast trabecular & nipple areole complex thickening in left breast & a group of microcalcifications & a large dense LN in axilla.

MRI: irregular 50*20*30 mm mass in central & superior of left breast that involve nipple B6

CNB: multiple foci of LCIS & FNA axilla was negative

She underwent incisional biopsy: its result was extensive DCIS & LCIS

She underwent SSM+ DTI+SLNB

Pathology: ILC, 3mm in the area of extensive DCIS, G2, LCIS +, superior margin involved by invasive & in situ component, multifocal, LVI-, 2 SLN negative , 3 intrammary LN negative , ER+,PR+, HER2-, Ki67 5%

Recommendation:

Margin reexcision after MRI & Tamoxifen & OS & genetic test are recommended.
