Patient presentation: A 36 year-old woman with negative family history known case of right breast cancer in 1396.

Right mastectomy - SLNB and tissue expander

IDC, G2, multicentric, T2, N2, M0

ER+, Her2 +++, Ki67 30%

LN 7/19 involved

Chemo- XRT- Herceptin- Tamoxifen

Now: rise in CA15-3 (58)

PET CT: Right liver lobe metastasis

Liver biopsy: malignant, ER+, Her2 negative, Ki67 15%

Question:

What's the next plan?

Does she need surgery for her metastasis or chemotherapy?

Recommendation:

MRI is recommended & if she has single metastasis then upfront surgery is recommended.
