Patient presentation: A 43 year-old lady who underwent mastectomy & ALND in 1399.

Pathology: IDC, G1, ER -, PR -, HER-2 2+, FISH +. 14 LNs are free from tumor. Then she underwent chemotherapy and radiotherapy. She has presented with multiple skin nodules since 2 months ago.

US: infraclavicular LNs B4a

The patient referred to undergo operation but in **PET-CT:** there was uptake in intramammary LNs and subpectoral region

Question:

What's the next plan?

Recommendation:

1. Biopsy from lesions & IHC are recommended.
2. If HER-2 is positive then surgery is recommended.
3. If HER-2 is negative then systemic therapy is recommended.
