Patient presentation: A 40 year-old woman with left Breast cancer. She took 6 courses of chemotherapy and Anti HER-2. After Chemotherapy, Supraclavicular Lymph node is resolved and Breast mass is 11mm.

Biopsy of Supraclavicular Lymph node: Metastatic Large cell undifferentiated.

Bone scan: Not typical for metastasis in pubis.

CNB: IDC, ALN: positive, Triple positive, Ki67: 40%.

Question:

Does she need surgery or not?

Recommended plan:

- 1- PET Scan (for mediastinal LNs)
- 2- Primary site resection.

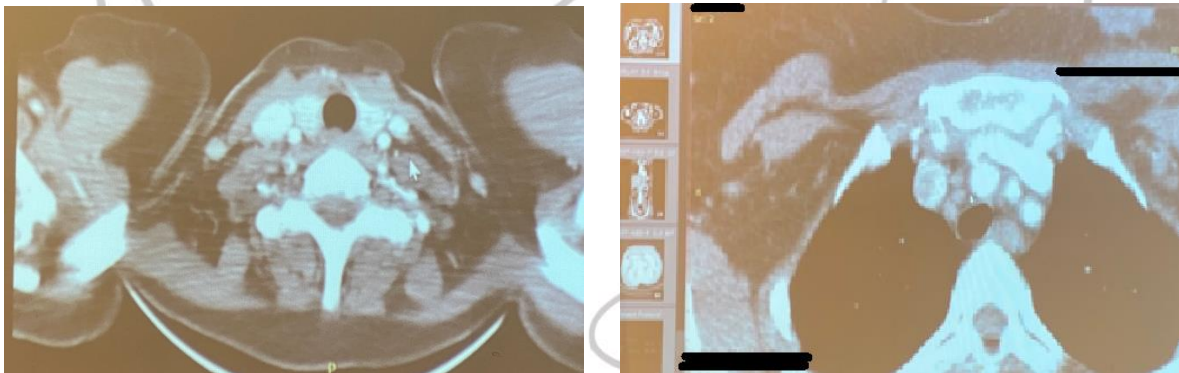


Figure 1, 2: Supraclavicular and Mediastinal Lymphnodes
