**Patient presentation:** A 70 year-old woman that underwent right Neoadjuvant Chemotherapy, Mastectomy and Radiotherapy in year 1390 and Letrozole intake. Now from 2 months ago, she presented with Erythema and skin lesion on left side of neck and infra clavicle.

**Sonography:** Multiple suspicious lymph node in supra clavicle and neck.  
CNB of supra clavicle skin lesion: Metastasis with Breast origin, ER: positive, PR: negative, HER-2: single positive.

**Question:**

What is the next plan?

**Recommended plan:**

- 1- Considering the metastatic lesions from first cancer, since left breast imaging seems normal, she is candidate for change in Chemotherapy line and change in Hormone-therapy.
- 2- Also PET scan and Breast MRI can reassure the cancer site.
