Patient presentation: A 54 year-old woman with Chest pain and then underwent CT scan then Biopsy. She is known case of metastatic Neuroendocrine tumor of Lung (Ki67: 10-12%), 4 years ago. She underwent XRadiotherapy and 3 sessions of Lu-dotatate. Since the diagnose of metastasis in both Breasts, Axillas and Ovary, she underwent f/u treatment and PET scan. Now she has metastases only in both Breasts and Axillas.

Question:

Does she need surgery of Breasts and Axillas?

Recommended plan:

- 1- Since multiple metastases are considered as high grade, there is no need of debulking.
- 2- Octreotide scan must be done then Tacrolimus and Lu-dotatate
- 3- If any residue left, use Radiotherapy.
- 4- Again will be consulted in MDT.
