Patient presentation: A 41 year-old woman with family history of uterus cancer in her sister, has a mass in her left breast, she underwent breast-Conserving Surgery (BCS) and Sentinel lymph node biopsy (SLNB).

CNB: ILC, Grade: 2, ER: positive, PR: positive, HER-2: positive, Ki67: 25%.

Pathology: Size: 47mm, Margins: free, Left Breast extra Nodule: Invasive Carcinoma, SLN: free, ER: positive, PR: positive, HER-2: negative, Ki67:16%.
