Patient presentation: A 48 year-old woman with positive family history of breast cancer in her mother, sister and aunt, and colon cancer in her uncle. She has history of bilateral mammoplasty 3 years ago

Screened mammography and sonography: BIRADS: 2.

Genetic test: BRCA is negative.

Question:

Is prophylactic bilateral mastectomy recommended?

Recommended plan:

Considering to negative genetic test:

- 1-High risk screening and follow up with MRI is recommended.
- 2-Chemoprophylaxy could be suggested if the patient accepts it.
