Patient presentation: A 49 year-old woman known case of cutaneous neurofibromatosis, and locally advanced breast cancer and lymph adenopathy (LAP) in the breast MRI but not palpable in the P/E, after neoadjuvant chemotherapy (NAC) she underwent mastectomy and SLNB.

Frozen section: 3 Sentinel lymph nodes were negative.

Pathology: ½ lymph node was positive for malignancy (2 foci<1mm).
