Patient presentation: A 58 year-old woman with self-history of left breast cancer treated with Breast-conserving surgery (BCS), Sentinel Lymphnode Biopsy (SLNB), Chemotherapy and Radiotherapy of right Axilla for 2 times.

CNB: ER: positive, PR: positive, HER-2: negative, Ki67: 10%.

Sonography: Left Supraclavicular and right Axillary Lymph nodes.

PET scan: Axillary lymphnode with high SUV.

CNB of Axilla: Inflammation.

Question:

What is the plan for right axillary lymph node?

Recommended plan:

- 1-Check for CA15-3 and CEA
- 2- Breast MRI
- 3- 3-month follow up of axilla with sonography
