- Continue Endocrine therapy.

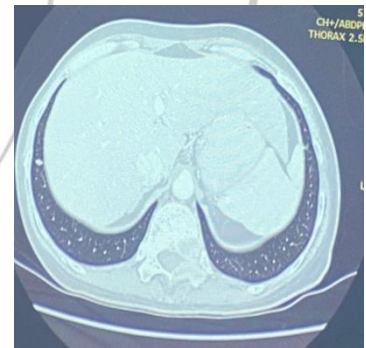
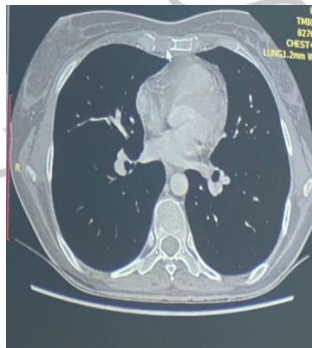
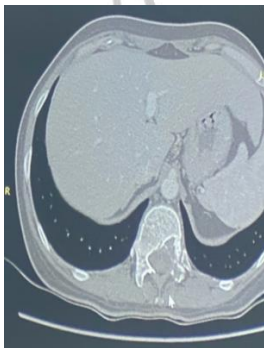


Figure1, 2: Vertebra and Sternum Lesions on CT scan
