Patient presentation: A 72 year-old woman with history of right breast cancer in year 1396 who underwent BCS and SLNB (0/1) (IDC, ER: negative, PR: negative, HER-2: double positive, FISH: negative, Ki67: 60%, Tumor size: 10mm, Grade: 3, Margins: free). She underwent Adjuvant Chemo-radiotherapy.

Now she has a 7mm left breast mass. She underwent Vacuumed resection of lesion then and complete basket vacuum resection for margins: IDC, Tumor size: 4mm, Grade: 2, ER: positive, PR: positive, HER-2: negative, Ki67: 10%, Basket: free. No suspicious lymph node in any imaging.

Question:

Is she a candidate for adjuvant therapy and no more surgery?

Recommended plan:

- No further surgery, Endocrine therapy with or without systemic therapy.




Figure 1 & 2: Mammography.
