Patient presentation: A 43 year-old woman with 5 right Breast masses in UOQ with the largest tumor size of 44mm. She underwent skin spare mastectomy and direct-to-implant.

CNB: Infiltrative calcification and extracellular Mucin, ER: 90%, PR: positive, HER-2: negative, Ki67: 12%.

Pathology: Mucinous carcinoma, Tumor size: 36mm, Grade: 1, Nodes: 0/10 node in tail of breast, ER: 100%, PR: 100%, HER-2: double positive, Ki67: 10%.

Question:

What is the plan for adjuvant therapy?

Recommended plan:

- No need of chemotherapy or Radiotherapy, just Endocrine therapy.
