Patient presentation: A 68-year-old woman underwent chemotherapy since Azar 1402 due to metastatic breast cancer (IDC, Grade: 3, with lymph node metastasis, triple negative, Ki67: 40 %) to the bone (lumbar spine, more prominent in L3, L4 and sacrum) and liver (17mm segment VII, 36 mm segment IV). After 8 sessions of chemotherapy, the bone and liver lesions have partially responded. In whole body bone scan compared to previous study bone lesions in sacrum and L3 showed less activity and no new lesion is noted.
