Patient presentation: A 56 year-old woman has had liver transplant because of primary sclerosing cholangitis in 1391, and right breast mass in 4 and 10 o'clock in year 1393. She underwent Mastectomy and SLNB of right side and has been taking Aromatase Inhibitor until now.

CNB: Complex sclerosis lesion and few foci of DCIS, ER: 2%, PR: negative.

Pathology: DCIS, Tumor size: 30 mm, SLNB: 0/1.

Question:

Because of cosmetic reasons, is she a candidate for breast reconstruction or contra lateral mastectomy?

Recommended plan:

- Because of immunosuppressive agents, she has a delayed healing and Mastectomy is beneficial.
