Patient presentation: A 60 year-old woman known case of Invasive Ductal Carcinoma of Breast and underwent BCS 3years ago. Due to Corona virus Chemotherapy didn't complete and no Radiotherapy was done. She has a supraclavicular lymph node since 6 months ago. She underwent Carboplatin, Paclitaxel and Trastuzumab.

CNB: Metastasis of breast cancer

IHC: GATA: positive, ER: negative, PR: negative, HER-2: positive.

PET scan: Normal.

Thoracic MRI: Early metastatic deposit in T8.

Question:

What is the treatment plan?

Recommended plan:

- 1- Radiation of breast and node.
- 2- Biopsy of bone lesion and if not possible consider as single metastasis.
- 3- Follow-up of neck lesion.
- 4- Continue Trastuzumab for 1 year.
