**Patient's Name:** M.P

**Patient presentation:** A 43 year-old woman with right Breast mass.

**Sonography:** A 40mm mass, UOQ, suspicious lymph node.

**Mammography:** DCIS around mass.

**CNB:** IDC, Grade: 1, ER: 70%, PR: 80%, HER-2: negative, Ki67: 35%.

**CT scan:** Suspicious bone metastasis (2/2: multiple thoracic spine & Lumbar Metastases and 2/6: sclerotic lesions).

**Bone Scan:** 6<sup>th</sup> rib is suspicious, to be discussed post NAC.

**Question:**

Does she need surgery or Chemotherapy?

**Recommended plan:**

- As bone scan was normal, primary site resection is recommended.
