Patient presentation: A 49 year-old woman known case of left Breast Cancer. She underwent 4 sessions of NAC, MRM, Chemoradiotherapy, Tamoxifen and then Letrozole in year 1395. After 7 years, she had a mass in Mastectomy bed (Biopsy: Metastasis of ILC, HER-2: positive) and she underwent the resection of rib and Mastectomy bed in year 1402.

She has taken Palbociclib & Faslodex. Now she presented with rise of CA15-3.

CNB: ILC, ER: positive, PR: positive, HER-2: negative.

Bone scan: Normal.

Brain MRI: Normal.

Adrenal PET scan: Suspicious.

Adrenal MRI: Normal.

- Review of imaging suggests a Gastrointestinal or pancreatic source
- Diagnostic Laparotomy or Laparoscopy
