Patient presentation: A 63 year-old woman showed Bone lesion because of Bone pain checkup, biopsy showed metastatic lesion (GATA: positive), She underwent Hormone therapy.

Imaging: multiple Bone Metastasis, right breast mass in tail and Axilla.

Biopsy: ILC, Grade: 1, ECAD: negative, ER: 90%, PR: 90%, HER-2: negative, Ki67: 50%.

PET scan: Decreased uptake in bone lesion.
