Patient presentation: A 25 year-old woman known case of breast cancer.

Mammography: Right breast mass in 10 o'clock.

Pathology: DCIS, ER: 60%, PR: 30%, also a small less than 3 mm invasive component with HER-2: triple positive, Ki67: 5%.

MRI:

Left: one non-mass enhancement, BIRADS: 4a, which was not found in US.

Right: many non-mass enhancements, BIRADS: 4b & 4c, one suspicious Lymph node in Axilla.

Question:

What is the treatment plan?

Recommended plan:

- 1- Chemotherapy.
- 2- Genetic consultation.
- 3- Skin spare Mastectomy of right side and SLNB.
- 4- Then MRI guided biopsy of left breast mass.
