Patient presentation: A 37 year-old woman she had right breast mass in 1400 (ILC, ER: positive, PR: positive, HER-2: negative, Ki67: 15%, ECAD: negative.) She underwent Neoadjuvant Chemotherapy, Mastectomy, 2 SLNBs, 1 macro-metastasis and 3 micro-metastases out of 8 ALNDs and then Radiotherapy; Palbociclib and Faslodex. Ca15.3 decreased at first now 115 for 5 month and no reduce in level.

Pathology: Tumor size: 70mm, Rise in ca15.3 and anemia, Bone marrow: metastatic with breast origin, HER-2: negative, ER: negative, ER: 40, PR: negative, CK7: positive, Pdl1 check: negative.

Question:

What is the next plan?

Recommended plan:

- If she is clinically stable and there is no sign of Anemia Thrombocytopenia or Neutropenia, continue current regimen.
