**Patient presentation:** A 37 year-old woman who had a right breast mass (IDC, negative, PR: negative, HER-2: negative, Ki67: 5%) in year 1399. She underwent Neoadjuvant Chemotherapy, BCS, SLNB and then Radiotherapy. She had recurrence in year 1401 and underwent MRM (Tumor size: 15\*15mm, ER: negative, PR: negative, HER-2: negative, Ki67: 22%) and then 12 session Xeloda.

Since 3 month ago skin lesions have appeared.

**Biopsy:** ER: negative, PR: negative, HER-2: negative, Ki67: 42%.

**PET scan:** High up take in lung.

**Question:**

Is she candidate for surgery?

**Recommended plan:**

- Biopsy from lung, if it's negative, then surgery.
