Patient presentation: A 76 year old woman with history of RT MRM followed by chemotherapy (ACT) and Aromazine referred to clinic due to suspicious mass in Mammography of left Breast. Sonography showed 10 mm mass in UOQ and at least 5 enlarged lymph nodes with cortical thickening.

CNB was done and pathologic results showed ILC classic type, with metastasis to Lymph node (ER: 90%, PR: 90%, HER-2: negative, Ki67: 5%, E-cadherin: negative).

- 2- Surgery
