Patient presentation: A 63 year old woman with family history of breast cancer in third degree who underwent VAB due to intermittent nipple discharge, pathologic results showed ADH and then wire guided lumpectomy was done. Surgical pathologic results showed intraductal papilloma with small focus of low grade DCIS.

Question:

What is the best treatment plan?

Recommended plan:

- 1- Review slides of pathologic
- 2- If one foci of DCIS confirmed XRT can be omitted
- 3- Chemoprevention with Tamoxifen or Letrozole.
