Patient presentation: A 56 year-old woman with history of right breast cancer underwent BCS followed by chemotherapy, radiotherapy and Tamoxifen (10 years) in 1393 referred to clinic due to IDC, Grade: 2, LVI: negative, ER: strongly positive, PR: 80%, HER: double positive, CISH: negative, Ki67: 8%.

Mammography: new obscured mass in inner central part of right breast,

Sonography: 6 mm mass in near to mid zone 2-3 o'clock.

She underwent re BCS and SLNB was done and final pathologic results showed IDC, Grade: 1, Tumor size: 8 mm, LVI: positive, SLNB: 0/3, NSLN: 0/4.
