Due to favorable pathology chemotherapy omitted, after 4 sessions of XRT.

Sonography done for seroma evaluation, incidentally one suspicious intramammary lymph node found in UOQ which was infiltrated by cancer according to CNB.

Question:

What is the best next plan?

Recommended plan:

- 1- Wire excision of intramammary lymph node
- 2- Oncologist consult (Chemotherapy 50-50)
- 3- RT high tangent
