- 2- Surgery if possible

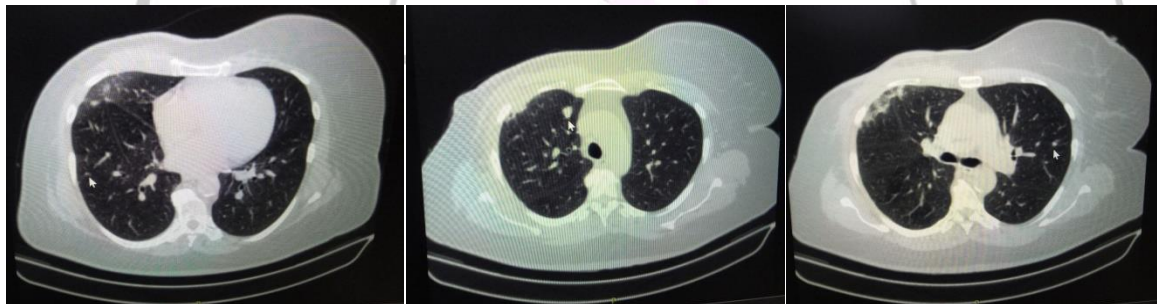


Figure 1, 2 & 3: CT scan shows nodule and consolidation in right lung.
