**Patient presentation:** A 38-year-old woman is examined by palpation of a mass following her first pregnancy, and BIRADS 2 lesion is reported in ultrasound, mammography and MRI, which is recommended short term follow-up.

In 1403, the patient was re-examined due to the desire for IVF, and according to the BIRADS IVa lesion of the left breast, she underwent vacuum assistant biopsy, and pathologic results showed UDH, according that, wire excisional biopsy was done, and the pathology of intraductal papilloma and DCID with a size of 4mm was reported. Reviewing the slides rules out DCIS and showed florid ductal hyperplasia and adenosis. The patient wants bilateral mastectomy and primary reconstruction.
