- 2- If suspected lesions are seen excision is recommended

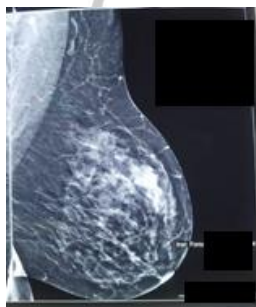


Figure 1: Mammogram suspicious microcalcification.

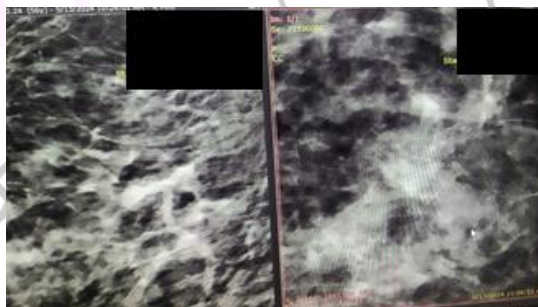


Figure2: Specimen mammogram shows microcalcification.
