**Patient's Name:** S.S

**Patient presentation:** A 36 year-old woman who came to MDT previously and had right breast mass in year 1399. She underwent Neoadjuvant Chemotherapy, BCS, SLNB and Radiotherapy (ER: negative, PR: negative, HER-2: negative, Ki67: 5%). She had recurrence in 1401 and underwent MRM and then 12 sessions of Xeloda (Tumor size: 15mm, ER: negative, PR: negative, HER-2: negative, Ki67: 22%). Since 3 month ago she had skin lesions.

**PET CT scan:** 20 mm nodule in Lung in favor of metastasis, no proven biopsy. Resection of Mastectomy bed performed, now she has nodularity in mastectomy bed:

**Sonography:** 2 masses 7.5 mm and 4.5 mm in lateral side of chest wall.

**Question:**

What is the next plan?

**Recommended plan:**

- 1- Check BRCA1
- 2- Systemic therapy
- 3- check PDL1 if >1% then immunotherapy
- 4- No further local excision
