**Patient presentation:** A 46 year-old woman referred to clinic due to papillary thyroid cancer (Right lobe 16, 18 mm nodule workup cervical Lymphadenopathy that confirmed with FNA) and right breast IDC (Grade: 2, ER: negative, PR: negative, HER-2: negative, Ki67: 12%) with metastasis to the axillary lymph nodes.

**Sonography:** Breast mass in 7 o'clock 20mm, 4 suspicious lymph nodes.

- 1- Genetic test
- 2- Referred to oncologist for neoadjuvant Chemotherapy

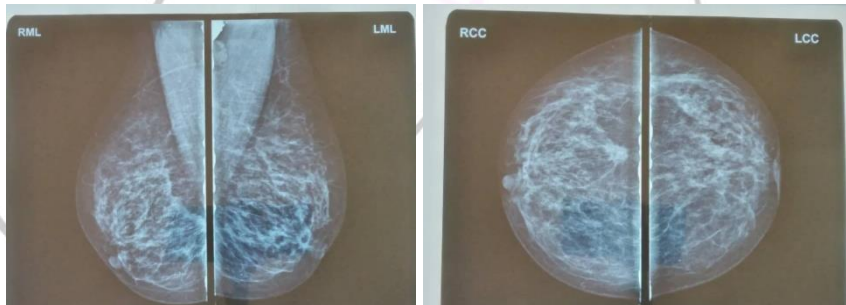


Figure 1 & 2: Mammography shows right breast mass.

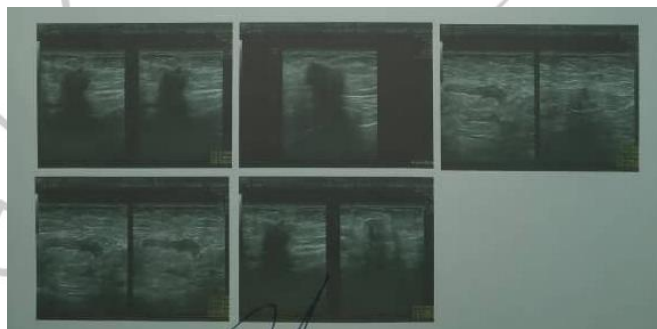


Figure 3: Sonography of breast shows breast mass.
